

COURSE SET UP FOR COMPETITIONS

1. Principal Events

- a. No multi-tee option
- b. In most cases, men will play the Gold course and women will play the White course.
- c. The conditions of competition for each event will clarify pre-event which course is in play.

2. Stroke Competitions

- a. No multi-tee option.
- b. Saturday medley stroke rounds – men will play the Gold course and women will play the White course.
- c. Thursday women's stroke rounds – women will play the White course.

3. Weekly Competitions

- a. Normal weekly competitions will have the multi tee options of:
 - i. Blue Women
 - ii. White Women
 - iii. Blue Men
 - iv. White Men

4. Social Play

- a. Members playing socially may choose to play whichever course is available on the day.

HOW MULTI-TEE COMPETITIONS WILL WORK

In a normal weekly competition, Members will have the option to choose which course (colour tees) they would like to play.

How it will work:

- Members will check into the Golf Shop as normal.
- For men's competitions – the default course will be set as the blue course.
- For women's competitions – the default course will be set as the white course.
- For medley competitions – the default course for men will be the blue course and the default course for women will be the white course.
- If members want to play on the other available course they will need to advise staff at registration, otherwise they will be assigned to the men's or women's default tee.
- Staff will endeavour to remind members of their choice.
- A member's daily handicap will change according to the rating of the course they choose.
- Members in a multi-tee competition will be in the same competition as other golfers playing off different tees.

PRIZE PAYOUTS

There will be no change to the prize payouts. Prize payouts will be reviewed after three months.
